The concept

The Hogeschool-Universiteit Brussel, in collaboration with the Trade Union for European Civil Servants (SFE), organises a training in preparation of the open competitions, organised by the European Personnel Selection Office (EPSO).

For whom?

This training is designed for anyone who wants to know more about the European Union and especially for candidates who want to take part in EpsO competitions. Prior knowledge is not required!

The training courses

During 10 evenings, different facets will be dealt with in detail.

1. How to apply for a job + a history of the European Union
2. The Institutions and decision-making
3. Numerical and verbal skills
4. The European budget
5. The economic cohesion
6. Other European policies
7. The Common agricultural policy
8. The competition policy
9. The written test
10. The oral test

How it works

After each session you will get a full handout of the PowerPoint materials as well as additional resources. Participants in the EPSO contests will get answers to their questions.

You will receive the latest edition of the book "250 MCQ on Europe", available in English, French or German.

Participants will have access to a website, with all presentations, additional information and documents and tests online.

The speakers

All speakers are selected among the European Union staff on the basis of their training experience and their specialist expertise.

The fee

370 euros for 10 evenings.
